The Export-Import Bank of India [hereafter Exim Bank, or the Bank], on behalf of the Government of India (GOI), extends from time-to-time, concessional credit facilities under the Indian Development and Economic Assistance Scheme (IDEAS) to overseas governments / their nominated agencies in developing countries for financing projects involving procurement of goods, civil works, consultancy and non-consultancy services to be contracted to Indian entities.

These Lines of Credit (LOCs) are governed by the Guidelines issued by the GOI from time-totime. As per the extant guidelines issued vide letter No. 21/3/2015-IDEAS dated December 7, 2015, the Bank is required to carry out a prequalification exercise and provide a list of prequalified bidders to the Borrower for invitation of bids for specific contract packages under the project(s) financed by the LOCs.

In pursuance to the above, the Bank invites Applications from eligible Indian entities for prequalification of Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Contractors for Establishment of Water and Sewerage Networks in 34 Islands in the Maldives under a Line of Credit extended to the Government of the Republic of Maldives.

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Part I. Scope of Work Description of the Scope

The Export-Import Bank of India (Exim Bank or the Bank), on behalf of the Government of India (GOI), under the Indian **D**evelopment and **E**conomic **A**ssistance **S**cheme (IDEAS) has approved financing of a project out of a Line of Credit (LOC) extended to the Government of the Republic of Maldives for Establishment of Water and Sewerage Networks in 34 Islands in the Maldives.

As per the extant guidelines of IDEAS, issued vide letter no. 21/3/2015-IDEAS dated December 7, 2015, the Bank is required to invite Expression of Interest from Indian entities and carry out a prequalification exercise and provide a list of prequalified entities to the Borrower for invitation of bids for specific contract packages under the project(s) financed by the Line(s) of Credit.

In pursuance of the above, the Bank now seeks applications for prequalification of Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Contractors from eligible Indian entities. Refer Part II ITA 4 for eligibility provisions.

A] Project Background




Figure 1 - Administrative Divisions of Maldives

Republic of Maldives consists of 1192 low lying coral Islands spread over an area of 90,000 km^2 in the Indian Ocean. Only 193 Islands are inhabited, around 90 Islands are resorts and the rest are uninhabited. There are 26 geographical Atolls which are grouped into 20 administrative Atolls as shown in **Figure 1**.

There are no surface water sources for potable use in Maldives. The available source is groundwater which is thin lens between 1 meter and 1.5 meter below the surface and another is rainwater. Ground water is particularly prone to pollution from human activities (improper sewerage and waste disposal) and saltwater inundation by the sea. Changing environmental conditions and urbanization of the islands does not make rainwater dependable throughout the year. In view of the same, desalinated water, via reverse osmosis from seawater is essential. This project aims at implementing Water supply system in 34 islands of Maldives.

Improper disposal of sewage and poorly constructed septic tanks make the shallow ground water lens susceptible to pollution and threatens the health of the island communities in Maldives. Accordingly, there is need for immediate action to improve sewerage facilities in the islands for protection of public health and environment. This project aims at implementing Sewerage system in 17 islands of Maldives.




Figure 2 - 34 Islands in the Project and their Packages

Ministry of National Planning and Infrastructure (MNPI), on behalf of the Government of Maldives, with support from the EXIM Bank of India, has appointed a Design and Project Management Consultant (DPMC) for the Project. <u>The DPMC is preparing a</u> <u>Preliminary Design Report, Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Report and Bid</u> <u>Documents on Engineering, Procurement and Construction basis for the Project.</u> 34 Islands under the Project are grouped into 6 Packages as shown in **Figure 2**. List of 34 islands in the Project and their basic data is presented in **Table 1**.




Figure 3 - Package 1: 6 Islands in 4 Atolls




Figure 4 - Package 2: 5 Islands in 3 Atolls




Figure 6 - Package 4: 7 Islands in 3 Atolls




Figure 7 - Package 5: 5 Islands in 2 Atolls





Figure 8 - Package 6: 6 Islands in 2 Atolls



B] Project Components

There are three types of works under the Design and Build Project. Each work comprises of specific components. These works and components are:

1. Rainwater Collection and Treatment

Rainwater collection network, Rainwater collection Tank, Treatment (filtration, disinfection, anti-scaling, degasification), and related pumping system as well as pipe network

The design criteria for Rainwater Harvesting will be based on the "Guidelines and Manual for Rain Water Harvesting in Maldives" published by Ministry of Housing Transport and Environment, Government of the Republic of Maldives, July 2009, and any subsequent revisions to the said guidelines.

2. Seawater Desalination and Supply

Intake Well, Raw Water Tank, RO Plant, Treated Water Tank, Brine Tank and related pumping system as well as pipe network

The design criteria for Seawater Desalination and Supply will be based on the "Design Criteria and Technical Specifications - Design and Construction of Water Treatment and Supply System" published by Environmental Protection Agency under Ministry of Environment and Energy, Government of the Republic of Maldives.

The Water Supply System design will be based on IWRM systems which include the following components (where any of these components is available in the island, the system will be designed to integrate this with the other components).

- Rainwater Collection: Rainwater will be collected from public building roof catchments via a gravity network. Thereafter, collected rainwater would fall into a sump located at Water Treatment Plant (WTP) Facility or at a specific location on the island. Rainwater would be pumped into Raw Water Storage Tank by an automatic operation of submersible pumps at collection sump.
- Rainwater Treatment: Rainwater will undergo ultra-filtration and Ultraviolet (UV)/Chlorine disinfection treatment at WTP facility. Treated rainwater is then transferred into mixing tank.
- Sea Water Intake: 02 numbers of Water intake bore wells would be constructed at WTP Plot Area.
 Seawater would be pumped, by submersible pumps placed inside the well or dry mounted pumps placed near the top of borehole, into feed water tanks.
- Desalination System: Feed water would be pumped through multimedia filters; this filtered water is pretreatment water. After pretreatment, the high pressure pumps will then pump the raw water through Reverse osmosis (RO) membranes. The permeate (treated water) at the outlet will go through disinfection and then into mixing tanks. From mixing tanks, water would flow to storage tanks. Brine Rejected from the RO process is transferred to brine tank which will be pumped to sea via brine outfall.
- Distribution Network: Storage tanks will be connected to distribution pumps which would supply the water to the entire islands. Chlorine dosing would be carried into the distribution network. Each household would be provided with a metered water

supply connection.

 Solar power: WTP and administration building roof area will have photovoltaic modules for generation of solar power. The electricity will be used either directly to run the WTP or fed into island grid to supplement the energy demand of the RO plants.

3. Sewage Collection, Treatment and Disposal

Sewage Treatment Plant, Sewer Outfall and related pumping system as well as pipe network

The design criteria for Sewage Collection, Treatment and Disposal system will be based on the "Design Criteria and Technical Specifications for Conventional Gravity Sewerage Systems" published by Environmental Protection Agency under Ministry of Environment and Energy, Government of the Republic of Maldives, and any subsequent applicable revision to the said guidelines/specifications.

The Sewerage System design will include the following components (where any of these components is available in the island, the system will be designed to integrate this with the other components).

- Gravity Catchments: Each Household will be provided with a catch pit and a lateral connection which will discharge the sewage into sewer mains. The lateral pipelines would be 110mm uPVC pipes and sewer mains network will use 160mm uPVC pipes. Cleanouts or maintenance shafts would be placed at the starting point of the gravity line. Manholes would be placed at junctions or/and at every 60m in the main line.
- Lift Stations: The Sewer mains will discharge sewage into lift Stations (LS). Lift Stations will be fitted with two submersible pumps. Based on the sewage levels within the lift station sump, the pumps will operate automatically to discharge the sewer into pressure network.
- Pressure Network, pump station and outfall: Sewage Pumped into pressure network from lift stations located at each catchment will be discharged into outfall pump station or Sewage treatment Plant (STP). The discharge will be directed into sea, away from the reef edge and into a minimum depth of 6 m.

The Contractor will be responsible for the successful commissioning of all the equipment and on completion of trial run period and successful handing over to the Client.

C] Contract Execution Period

The duration of the contract is expected to be 15 - 22 months (Fifteen to Twenty-two months) plus Defects Liability Period of 12 months (Twelve months).

D] <u>GOI Guidelines</u>

As per the GOI guidelines, goods and services for minimum 75% value of the contracts covered under the Lines of Credit, must be sourced from India. Applicants are advised to refer to the GOI guidelines mentioned above which are also available at:

Part II. Instructions to Applicants [ITA]

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Part II. Instructions To Applicants

A. General

3.

- 1. Background

 The Export-Import Bank of India (hereinafter called "the Bank"), on behalf of the Government of India (GOI), extends from time-to- time, concessional credit facilities (hereinafter called "Lines of Credit") under the Indian Development and Economic Assistance Scheme (IDEAS) to overseas governments or their nominated agencies (hereinafter called "Borrower or Employer"), for financing projects to be executed by Indian entities. Payment by the Bank to the Indian exporters will be made only at the request of the Borrower and upon approval by the Bank, and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the credit (or financing) agreement.
- Scope of Prequalification
 2.1 With reference to the Invitation for Prequalification (IFP) indicated in Part III, Data Sheet (DS), this Application Document ("Application Document") is being issued by the Bank to prospective applicants ("Applicants") interested in submitting applications ("Applications") for prequalification as per the scope described in Part I, Scope of EPC and subject to the provisions of this Application Document.
 - 3.1 The Bank requires Applicants to participate in this prequalification process with the highest standards of ethics and integrity. It is strictly forbidden to the parties involved in the prequalification process, by themselves or by a third party, to offer, ask or accept for itself or for a third party, financial or non-financial advantage or even direct or indirect promise or any other acts¹, as offsets for prequalification or bidding or contract award and execution as applicable, if susceptible of being qualified as criminal unlawful acts in accordance with national laws of any party involved.
 - 3.2 In pursuance of ITA 3.1 above, Applicants shall permit the Bank to inspect all accounts, records and other documents relating to the submission of the Application, bid submission (in case prequalified), and contract performance (in the case of award), and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the Bank.
 - 3.3 If, in accordance with the administrative procedures of the Bank, it is demonstrated that an Applicant in this prequalification process, or during the subsequent bidding for the contract(s) has violated the provisions stated in ITA 3.1 above, the Bank, inter alia,

- a. shall reject any Application for prequalification or proposal to award a contract in connection with the subsequent procurement process, as applicable; and/or
- b. may declare an Applicant, temporarily or permanently, ineligible to be awarded future contracts under Bank funding.
- 4.1 This prequalification exercise is open to only Indian Applicants in accordance with the provisions of ITA 4.4. Any form of association by the Applicant with ineligible entities either during this prequalification process or subsequent bidding process may be liable for rejection.
- 4.2 For the purpose of applying the eligibility criteria listed in this article 4, "Applicant" would include the single entity or in case of a joint venture ("JV"), each member of the JV, involved or intended to be involved with this prequalification process (as mentioned in Form A.1.2 Applicant's JV Member's Information Form), for any part of the prospective contract(s) including related services.
- 4.3 An Applicant may be a single entity or a combination of entities in the form of a JV either existing or with the intent to enter into a JV supported by a letter of intent or JV Agreement listing out the names of all the JV members. In the case of a JV, all members shall be jointly and severally liable for the execution of the contract(s) in accordance with the respective contract terms. The JV shall be represented by an authorized representative who shall have the authority from all members of the JV to conduct all business for and on behalf of the JV during the prequalification process. The limit on the number of members in a JV would be as specified in the **DS**.
- 4.4 This prequalification exercise is open to only Indian Applicants. An Applicant shall be deemed to be Indian if the Applicant is constituted, incorporated or registered, and operates in accordance with the provisions of the laws of India, as evidenced by its articles of incorporation and its registration documents, as the case maybe.
- 4.5 An Applicant that has been blacklisted/debarred/ sanctioned by any Multilateral Development Agency (MDA) or any authority in India or the borrowing country in accordance with extant rules and procedures, shall be ineligible to participate in the prequalification/bidding process as applicable, during such period of time as the sanctioning authority shall have determined. In case the Applicant is blacklisted/debarred/sanctioned post the prequalification process (i.e. including during bidding process and /on Project implementation phase), the

4. Eligibility of Applicants

Applicant shall immediately inform Exim Bank of such blacklisting/ debarment/sanction and reasons thereof. This may lead to cancellation of prequalification / contract.

- 4.6 The list of debarred firms and individuals by certain leading MDAs is available as specified in the **DS**. This may not be an exhaustive list of debarred entities but those which are made available centrally on the respective MDA's website. Additionally, there could be lists of debarred entities issued by various government departments/ procuring entities/ corporations and maintained offline.
- 4.7 An Applicant shall be ineligible to be prequalified if [a] it is currently under default on any loan to any Bank/Financial Institution (FI) and its account has been classified as Non-Performing Asset (NPA)as per Central Repository of Information on Large Credits (CRILC) database; and [b] its promoters/directors appear in Negative List, RBI Wilful Defaulter List (Suit filed as well as non-suit filed), Credit Information Bureau India Ltd. (CIBIL) Defaulter List and/ or any other negative list of central and/or state government agencies, updated from time to time. On being included in any of the above lists post the prequalification process (i.e. during bidding including process and/or Project implementation phase), the Applicant shall immediately inform Exim Bank on the inclusion and reasons thereof. This may lead to cancellation of pregualification / contract.
- 4.8 An Applicant shall furnish such evidence of eligibility satisfactory to the Bank, as the Bank shall reasonably request.

 - 5.2 Unless obtained directly from the Bank, the Bank shall not be responsible for the completeness of the document, responses to requests for clarification, or Addenda to the Application Document in accordance with ITA 7. In case of any discrepancies, documents issued directly by the Bank shall prevail.

- 5.3 An Applicant is expected to study all instructions, and forms in the Application Document and to furnish with its Application all information or documentation as is required by the Application Document.
- 6. Clarifications 6.1 A prospective Applicant requiring any clarification of the Application Document shall contact the Bank in writing at the Bank's address indicated in the DS. The Bank will respond in writing to any request for clarification provided that such request is received no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the deadline for submission of the applications. The Bank's response, at its discretion, may be put up on its website and shall include a description of the inquiry (without identifying its source) and corresponding clarification. As a result of a clarification the Bank may, if necessary, amend the Application Document in accordance with the provisions of ITA 7.
 - 6.2 Any modification to the Application Document that may become necessary as a result of the clarifications to the queries shall be made by the Bank exclusively through the use of a Corrigendum pursuant to ITA 7.

 - 7.2 Any Corrigendum or Addenda issued shall be deemed to be part of the Application Document and shall be published on the Bank's website.
 - 7.3 Post Corrigendum, in order to allow sufficient time to the prospective Applicants in preparing their Applications, or for other good reason, the Bank may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Applications in accordance with ITA16.2.

C. Preparation, Submission and Opening of Applications

- 8. Cost towards Application
 8.1 The Applicant shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Application. The Bank will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the prequalification process.
- 9. Language 9.1 The Application documentation and printed literature that are part of the Application, if in another language, shall be accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in English language, which shall be the governing language.

- 10. Documents constituting the Application

 13.1 To establish its qualifications in accordance with Part IV, Prequalification Criteria and Requirements, the Applicant shall provide the information requested in the corresponding Forms included in Part V without any alteration to the format. Applicant shall also complete the Questionnaire included in Part VI without any alteration to the questions. Each Form included in Part V and the Questionnaire in Part VI shall be duly signed by the authorized representative of the Applicant. In case of JV, authorized representative of the respective member shall sign. Non- compliance with this clause may result in summary rejection of the Application.
 - 13.2 If an Applicant does not manufacture or produce the goods it offers to supply, it shall submit documentation related to Manufacturer's Authorisation as specified in the **DS**.
 - 13.3 Wherever a monetary amount is to be stated, Applicant should indicate the USD equivalent using the rate of exchange determined as follows:
 - (a) Exchange rates shall be taken from the publicly available source identified in the **DS**. Any error in determining the exchange rates in the Application may be corrected by the Bank during evaluation;
