INVITATION FOR PREQUALIFICATION

The Export-Import Bank of India [hereafter Exim Bank, or the Bank], on behalf of the Government of India, extends from time to time, concessional credit facilities under the Indian Development and Economic Assistance Scheme [IDEAS] to overseas governments / their nominated agencies in developing countries for financing projects involving procurement of goods, civil works, consulting and non-consulting services to be contracted to Indian entities.

These Lines of Credit are governed by the Guidelines issued by the GOI from time to time. As per the extant guidelines issued vide letter no No. 21/3/2015-IDEAS dated December 7, 2015, the Bank is required to carry out a prequalification exercise and provide a list of prequalified bidders to the Borrower for invitation of bids for specific contract packages under the project[s] financed by the Line[s] of Credit.

In pursuance to the above, the Bank invites Applications from Indian firms for prequalification of an EPC Contractor for Replacement of Asbestos Pipes with UPVC Pipes and Water Supply Rehabilitation & Expansion Project in Greater Banjul Area in the Republic of Gambia under a Line of Credit of USD 22.50 million extended to the Government of the Republic of Gambia.

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PART I: SCOPE OF EPC

The Export-Import Bank of India [Bank], on behalf of the Government of India has extended a USD 22.50 million Line of Credit to the Government of the Republic of Gambia for Replacement of Asbestos Pipes with UPVC Pipes and Water Supply Rehabilitation & Expansion Project in Greater Banjul Area in the Republic of Gambia, for which the Bank now seeks applications for pre-qualification from eligible firms. Refer Part II ITA 4 for eligibility provisions.

A] Background and Major Components of the Project

The project location is the Greater Banjul Area (GBA), covering an area of 93 sq km, with a population of 357,000. Water in GBA is obtained from the underground water table and the National Water and Electricity Company Gambia Ltd (NAWEC) is responsible for the supply & conservation of potable water. NAWEC, Gambia's main utilities supplier, is involved in the generation and provision of electricity, drinking water & sewerage services for domestic, industrial & commercial use.

The main objective of the project is to rehabilitate & expand the water supply and replace all the existing asbestos water mains and provide distribution system to the new areas in the GBA, which caters to 26% of Gambia's population.

To attain the above, NAWEC proposes to engage the services of an EPC contractor to undertake the construction contract of the scheme including preparation to make shop drawings, detailed construction drawings, field investigations, preliminary testing of boreholes, schedule of works, installation drawings, As Built drawing etc with the objective that the water availability at the GBA is ensured as per the required parameters.

B] Scope of EPC

The present water supply system is based on extraction of ground water. The network consists of bore holes, treatment plants and distribution through overhead tanks. The water from the various boreholes is transmitted through the transmission mains to the transmission units where the water is provided aeration and chlorination, before being put to the distribution system. The present system has the following components:

The scope of the contract for the project shall include but not necessarily be limited to the following:

B.1 Drilling of New Boreholes

The tentative aquifer locations which could be used for the drilling of the eight new proposed boreholes have been identified.

The proposed boreholes have been named as BH1, BH2 and so forth till BH8 and are at elevations between 17.41 metres and 31.01 metres. The boreholes are located in 5 villages namely Mamuda, Sinjan, Banyakan, Yuna and Jambour.

B.2 Laying of raw water transmission main from the boreholes/wellfields to Sukuta Water Treatment Plant

The raw water from the eight boreholes is proposed to be transmitted to the Sukuta Water Treatment plant through a transmission main. The lengths of the different boreholes to the Rising Mains/ Sukuta Treatment Plant is in the range of 30 metres to 7,895 metres, with discharge between 20 lps & 140 lps and with outer diameter in the range of 160 mm to 500 mm.

The boreholes shall be provided with appropriate electric supply and the proper SCADA system for its operation & monitoring. Backup power provision for the running of the borehole pumps shall be provided from the DG set arrangement at Sukuta Water Treatment Plant. The boreholes would have discharge speed of 20 lps, with heads ranging between 88 metres & 113 metres and pump capacities between 30 KW & 37 KW.

B.3 Treatment and Storage at Sukuta Water Treatment Plant

The raw water coming from the new boreholes would be treated and stored at Sukuta treatment Plant before being transported further. This requires the following constructions:

- Aerator
Dimension - 12.5m x 5.0m with a height of 6m
Water would fall on the cascades and the aeration of the raw water would take place.
- Water Storage Tank
Dimension - 25m x 16m x 3m
Capacity - 1000 m³

Construction would be in front of the centrifugal pumps installed at the treatment plant.

○ Pumping arrangement to pump water to Fajara Treatment Plant

For the additional water from the new boreholes, the treated water would be pumped to Fajara Treatment Plant through an arrangement of centrifugal VFD pumps. There would be 3 pumps each discharging 80 lps with a total head of 51 metres each and a pump capacity of 75 KWs each.

○ Chlorination Arrangement

Bleaching powder type chlorination arrangement at the treatment unit for treating the raw water

○ Shifting of existing pipelines

The location of the proposed water storage tank will result in realigning the existing pressure mains of the treatment plant. These 300 mm diameter pipelines would be realigned to locate the storage tank at the proposed location.

B.4 Treated Water Rising Main from Sukuta to Fajara Treatment Plant:

The rising main with the following parameters, has been designed to pump water from Sukuta Treatment Plant to the Fajara Treatment Plant:

B.5 By Pass Arrangement

About 1,300 m before the Fajara Treatment Plant, the rising main is proposed to be teed-off with a part of the treated water being fed to the Kainfing overhead tank complex. The pipeline parameters required for the feeding of this tank is as under:

B.6 Distribution Network

Four (4) new distribution networks are proposed to be executed under the project, to pump water to different locations/ overhead water service reservoirs/ underground reservoirs, as the case may be. The work also involves construction of an overhead tank of 17 m staging height and capacity of 150 cum to distribute water by gravity. The proposed design of the distribution network envisages an outer pipeline diameter between 90 mm & 500 mm and length of 300 m to 47,500 m, with uPVC Class 3 pipes.

B.7 Underground Tank at Jambour

A ground water tank of 500,000 litres is proposed to collect water at the ground level from the Treatment plant. The water shall be pumped to the existing distribution system using VFD pumps with 15 metres head, discharge capacity of 54 m³/h and power of 15KW.

B.8 Replacement of existing Asbestos Pipeline

The main object of the project is to replace all the existing asbestos water mains in the Greater Banjul area with uPVC pipes. The pipes would need to be replaced in short lengths and a major area of the pipeline has been replaced with uPVC as and when it required maintenance. Accordingly, pipes in diameter between 80 mm & 300 mm have to be replaced for pipe lengths between 500 m to 56,250 m, with the total of 112,500 m.

Apart from the above, asbestos pipelines of about 25 km, with a diameter of 100 mm, also needs replacement in the North Bank Region serving the areas of Farafenni, Berending & Buniadu.

B.9 Replacement of Old Pumps

Replacement of seven (7) old, VFD & normal, centrifugal pumps at Sukuta Treatment Plant, with heads of 35 m & 60m, discharge of 180 m³/h & 288 m³/h and power of 30 KW & 75 KW.

Replacement of three (3) old, normal, centrifugal pumps at Fajara Treatment Plant, with heads of 20 m, discharge of 144 m³/h and power of 15 KW.

B.10 SCADA System

There are 20 boreholes at the Sukuta Treatment Plant, of which 5 have been put on the SCADA system. Hence, 15 boreholes need to be connected by SCADA system to the

treatment plant. Additionally, the 8 proposed boreholes shall also be provided with the SCADA system.

The SCADA equipment installed at the Treatment Unit has the capacity to monitor 30 boreholes. The proposed work would be to connect the existing 15 boreholes and the 8 new boreholes with the existing system, for proper monitoring.

Since no SCADA system is available at the Fajara Water treatment Plant, a new system would be installed to monitor the inflow from Sukuta Treatment Plant from the 8 new boreholes to Fajara.

Serrakunda Treatment Plant does not have any SCADA system at present. 11 boreholes are proposed to be provided the monitoring system through SCADA. Also, the overhead tanks and the underground tank in the complex need to be put on the SCADA system to assess the water inflow & outflow.

B.11 Procurement of machinery/ equipment for O & M

For operating & maintaining the set up in future, the following equipment is proposed to be procured:

B.12 DG Set for Back-up Power

A DG set of 125 kVA is proposed to be installed at the Serrakunda Treatment Plant to cater for the back-up requirement of the SCADA system.

B.13 Project Office with Laboratory

Construction of a building of about 400 sq ft, to house the project office, with a laboratory is envisaged. NAWEC shall provide proper land for the setting up of the project office & laboratory.

B.14 House Service Connections

It is proposed that 3,200 households would be provided with service connections for water metering.

C] Contract execution Period

The duration of the contract comprises execution period of 18 months and 12 months of Defect Liability Period, aggregating thirty (30) months.

D] GOI Guidelines

As per the GOI guidelines, goods and services for minimum 75% value of the contracts covered under these Lines of Credit, must be sourced from India. Part II. Instructions to Applicants [ITA]

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Part II. Instructions to Applicants

A. General

- 1. Background**
 - 1.1 The Export-Import Bank of India (hereinafter called “the Bank”), on behalf of the Government of India (GOI), extends from time to time, concessional credit facilities (hereinafter called “Lines of Credit”) under the Indian Development and Economic Assistance Scheme (IDEAS) to overseas governments or their nominated agencies (hereinafter called “Borrower or Employer”), for financing projects to be executed by Indian entities. Payment by the Bank to the Indian exporters will be made only at the request of the Borrower and upon approval by the Bank, and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the credit (or financing) agreement.
- 2. Scope of Pre-qualification**
 - 2.1 With reference to the Invitation for Pre-qualification (IFP) indicated in Part III, Data Sheet (DS), this Application Document (“Application Document”) is being issued by the Bank to prospective applicants (“Applicants”) interested in submitting applications (“Applications”) for pre-qualification as per the scope described in Part I, General Scope and subject to the provisions of this Application Document.
- 3. Ethics and Integrity**
 - 3.1 The Bank requires Applicants to participate in this pre-qualification process with the highest standards of integrity and ethics and prohibits any corrupt and, collusive / or fraudulent practices. It is strictly forbidden to the parties involved in the pre-qualification process, by themselves or by a third party, to offer, ask or accept for itself or for a third party, financial or non-financial advantage or even direct or indirect promise, as offsets for pre-qualification, if susceptible of being qualified as criminal unlawful acts in accordance with national laws of any party involved.
 - 3.2 In pursuance of article 3.1 above, Applicants shall permit the Bank to inspect all accounts, records and other documents relating to the submission of the Application, bid submission (in case prequalified), and contract performance (in the case of award), and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the Bank.
 - 3.3 If, in accordance with the administrative procedures of the Bank, it is demonstrated that an Applicant in this pre-qualification process, or during the subsequent bidding for the contract(s) has committed corrupt, fraudulent, or unethical practices, the Bank, inter alia, shall:
 - a. reject any Application for pre-qualification or proposal to award a contract in connection with the subsequent procurement process, as applicable; and/or

- b. declare an Applicant involved in corrupt practices, temporarily or permanently, ineligible to be awarded future contracts under Bank funding.

4. Eligibility of Applicants

- 4.1 This pre-qualification exercise is open to only Indian Applicants in accordance with the provisions of ITA 4.4. Any form of association by the Applicant with ineligible entities either during this pre-qualification process or subsequent bidding process may be liable for rejection.
- 4.2 For the purpose of applying the eligibility criteria listed in this article 4, "Applicant" would include the single entity or in case of a joint venture ("JV"), each member of the JV, involved or intended to be involved with this pre-qualification process (as mentioned in Form A.1.2 Applicant's/ JV Member's Information Form), for any part of the prospective contract(s) including related services.
- 4.3 An Applicant may be a single entity or a combination of entities in the form of a JV either existing or with the intent to enter into a JV supported by a letter of intent listing out the names of all the JV members. In the case of a JV, all members shall be jointly and severally liable for the execution of the subsequent contract(s) in accordance with the respective contract terms. The JV shall be represented by an authorized representative who shall have the authority from all members of the JV so as to conduct all business for and on behalf of the JV during the pre-qualification process. The limit on the number of members in a JV would be as specified in the **DS**.
- 4.4 This pre-qualification exercise is open to only Indian Applicants. An Applicant shall be deemed to be Indian if the Applicant is constituted, incorporated or registered in, and operates in accordance with the provisions of the laws of India, as evidenced by its articles of incorporation and its registration documents, as the case may be.
- 4.5 An Applicant that has been debarred/ sanctioned by the Bank in pursuance of ITA 3.1, including debarment/ sanction by any government procuring entity/ corporation or Multilateral Development Agencies (MDA) in accordance with extant rules and procedures, shall be ineligible to be prequalified, during such period of time as the Bank/ sanctioning authority shall have determined.
- 4.6 The list of debarred firms and individuals by certain leading MDAs is available as specified in the **DS**. This may not be an exhaustive list of debarred entities but those which are made available centrally

on the respective MDA's website. Additionally, there could be lists of debarred entities issued by various government departments/procuring entities/ corporations and maintained offline.

- 4.7 The Applicant shall confirm that it has not defaulted in any loan to any Bank/FI and its account has not been classified as Non-Performing Asset (NPA) with any Bank/FI. The Applicant has to further confirm that none of their companies/promoters/directors appear in ECGC Specific Approval List, RBI Caution List, RBI Wilful Defaulter List (Suit filed as well as non-suit filed) and CIBIL Defaulter List, updated from time to time. On being included in any of the above lists, the Applicant shall immediately inform Exim Bank on the inclusion and reason for inclusion thereof.
- 4.8 An Applicant shall furnish such evidence of eligibility satisfactory to the Bank, as the Bank shall reasonably request.

B. Composition of the Application Document

5. Contents of this Document

- 5.1 This Application Document consists of the Parts indicated below, and which should be read in conjunction with any Corrigendum issued in accordance with ITA 7.

 - Part III. Data Sheet (DS) to ITA
 - Part IV. Pre-qualification Criteria and Requirements
 - Part V. Forms
 - Part VI. Questionnaire for Applicants
- 5.2 Unless obtained directly from the Bank, the Bank shall not be responsible for the completeness of the document, responses to requests for clarification, or Addenda to the Application Document in accordance with ITA 7. In case of any discrepancies, documents issued directly by the Bank shall prevail.
- 5.3 An Applicant is expected to study all instructions, and forms in the Application Document and to furnish with its Application all information or documentation as is required by the Application Document.

6. Clarifications

- 6.1 A prospective Applicant requiring any clarification of the Application Document shall contact the Bank in writing at the Bank's address indicated in the **DS**. The Bank will respond in writing to any request for clarification provided that such request is received no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the deadline for submission of the applications. The Bank's response, which shall be put up on its

website, shall include a description of the inquiry (without identifying its source) and corresponding clarification. As a result of a clarification the Bank may, if necessary, amend the Application Document in accordance with the provisions of ITA 7.

- 6.2 Any modification to the Application Document that may become necessary as a result of the clarifications to the queries shall be made by the Bank exclusively through the use of a Corrigendum pursuant to ITA 7.

7. Corrigendum of Application Document

- 7.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of Applications, the Bank may amend the Application Document by issuing a Corrigendum.
- 7.2 Any Corrigendum or Addenda issued shall be deemed to be part of the Application Document and shall be published on the Bank's website.
- 7.3 Post Corrigendum, in order to allow sufficient time to the prospective Applicants in preparing their Applications, or for other good reason, the Bank may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Applications in accordance with ITA 16.2.

C. Preparation, Submission and Opening of Applications

8. Cost towards Application

- 8.1 The Applicant shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Application. The Bank will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the pre-qualification process.

9. Language

- 9.1 The Application documentation and printed literature that are part of the Application, if in another language, shall be accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in English language, which shall be the governing language.

10. Documents constituting the Application

- 10.1 The Application shall comprise the following:
- (a) Application Submission Form, in accordance with ITA 11.1;
 - (b) documentary evidence establishing the Applicant's eligibility, in accordance with ITA 12.1;
 - (c) documentary evidence establishing the Applicant's qualifications, in accordance with ITA 13; and
 - (d) any other document required as specified in the DS.

11. Application Submission Form

- 11.1 The Applicant shall complete an Application Submission Form as provided in Part V (Forms). This Form must be completed without any alteration to its format.

Deadline

Applications shall be received by the Bank at the address and no later than the deadline indicated in the **DS**.

16.2 The Bank may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Applications by amending the Application Document in accordance with ITA 7.

17. Late Applications

17.1 Applications received after the deadline for submission of applications shall not be admissible, and if received, shall be returned unopened to the Applicant.

18. Opening of Applications

18.1 The Bank shall open all Applications at the date, time and place specified in the **DS**. Applicants' representatives may be present during opening.

D. Procedures for Evaluation of Applications

19. Evaluation to be Confidential

19.1 Information relating to the Applications, their evaluation and result shall be confidential and will not be disclosed to Applicants or any other person(s) not officially concerned with the pre-qualification process until the official notification of pre-qualification results is made in accordance with ITA 25.

19.2 From the deadline for submission of Applications to the time of notification of the results of the pre-qualification in accordance with ITA 25, any Applicant who wishes to contact the Bank on any matter related to the pre-qualification process (except as specified in 20.1 below), may do so only in writing. Canvassing in any form will be grounds for disqualification.

20. Clarifications during Evaluation

20.1 During the evaluation of Applications, in case of ambiguity, the Bank may, at its discretion, ask an Applicant for a clarification of its Application, to be submitted within a stated reasonable period of time. Any request for clarification from the Bank and all clarifications from the Applicant shall be in writing.

20.2 If an Applicant does not provide (within the time allowed) clarifications and/or documents requested as per the Bank's request for clarification, its Application shall be evaluated based on the information and documents available at the time of evaluation of the Application.

21. Determination of Responsiveness of Applications

21.1 The Bank may reject any Application which is not responsive to the requirements of the Application Document.

E. Evaluation of Applications and Pre-qualification of Applicants

22. Evaluation of Applications

- 22.1 The Bank shall use the criteria and requirements defined in Part IV, Pre-qualification Criteria and Requirements, to evaluate the qualifications of the Applicants, and no other methods, criteria, or requirements shall be used. The Bank reserves the right to waive minor deviations from the pre-qualification criteria if they do not materially affect the technical capability and financial resources of an Applicant to perform the contract.
