Mongolia Assignment title: Selection of a Consultant to develop a detailed feasibility study on the construction of an oil refinery plant with a crude oil supply pipeline in Mongolia.

Within the scope of the Credit Line Agreement of the Government of Mongolia and the Export-Import Bank of India, the Ministry of Mining and Heavy Industry of Mongolia invites eligible Consultants to express their interest in developing a detailed feasibility study on the construction of an oil refinery plant with a crude oil supply pipeline in Mongolia.

In accordance with the Credit Line Agreement established on April 28, 2016 between the Government of Mongolia and the Export-Import Bank of India, the Guidelines on Lines of Credit extended by the Government of India (No.21/3/2015-IDEAS) issued on December 07, 2015 by the Ministry

of Finance of India, only Consultants registered/incorporated/established in India shall be eligible to express their interest.

Selection of the consultant will be conducted according to the Public Procurement Law of Mongolia.

Interested eligible consultants shall submit the following documents:

1. A copy of the national registration certificate of the firm;
2. A minimum of 5 years documented experience relating to the development of feasibility studies on oil refinery and crude oil pipeline projects internationally and regionally;
3. Information demonstrating that the consultant team has the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

The eligible consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications and to provide the services in short term.
