Towards this end, EXIM Bank is undertaking a survey of project exporters to assess the evolving landscape of the sector. The Survey seeks to analyse the emerging issues and potential opportunities for project exports arising from the current geopolitical developments in the region.

Further, the Survey also seeks to capture the data on the value of project exports from India. As you are aware, the non-availability of comprehensive and reliable data on project exports poses a challenge for policy-level analysis. To address this data gap, we are undertaking a collation of information on project export contracts secured by Indian companies over the past three years through the survey.
